

SUPERINTENDENT DUTIES

The Alexandria City School Board (Board) places the primary responsibility and authority for the administration of the school division in the Superintendent. The Superintendent is responsible for the direction, leadership, and coordination of students and staff in their efforts to reach educational goals adopted by the Board.

The Board expects the Superintendent to provide leadership in:

1. Decision-making;
2. Communication;
3. Planning, organizing, implementing, and evaluating educational programs; and
4. Developing and maintaining close working relationships and channels of communication within the school system and community.
