**TOPIC:** Update on the Status of ACPS Violent Intruder Training

**SUMMARY:** ACPS continues the process of conducting Violent Intruder Training for teachers and staff.

**BACKGROUND:** Training consists of an online course and practical exercises.

- Approximately 82% of ACPS teachers and staff have completed online training.
- Approximately 76% of ACPS teachers and staff have completed practical exercise training.
- 16 schools (~ 1,866 personnel) have completed teacher/staff practical exercise training (of 20 campuses).
- Mount Vernon (April 22) is scheduled to complete teacher/staff practical exercise training (~ 121 personnel).
- Jefferson-Houston, Patrick Henry and TC Williams Minnie Howard practical exercises to be scheduled before years end (~ 278 personnel).
- 2019-2020 goal is to start new school year with 100% of teachers and staff trained (includes new teachers).

**RECOMMENDATION:** The Superintendent recommends the School Board review and provide any questions for further follow up.
