Staff Recommendations



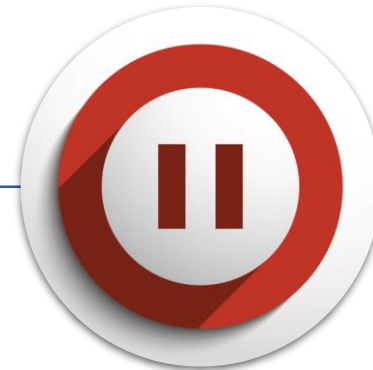
Make weapons abatement a permanent part of the security posture at secondary schools

- Continue working with stakeholders on improving process



Continue to report on efficacy of weapons abatement program

- Will occur during bi-annual safety presentations to School Board



Do not implement weapons abatement at elementary or K-8 schools at this time

- Recommend considering other measures to improve security posture at the elementary schools at this time
- Update School Board and community on changes to security measures prior to start of SY24-25
