The Summer Residential Governor's Mentorship in Engineering, hosted at the National Aeronautics and Space Administration (NASA)/Langley Research Center and the National Institute of Aerospace (NIA), is a free, summer program designed to provide challenging, real-life, team-oriented work experiences.

Students are given the opportunity to view engineering and research from a unique perspective and to become familiar with career options through their individual mentorships, their community time with other students, and their tour opportunities.

Mentorships:

- change each year based upon availability of NASA/NIA volunteer researchers
- are assigned based on student interest and experience, and
- occasionally, will be offered that are outside of a student's expectation and/or comfort zone

Applications are now being accepted. Selection is competitive. Not more than 12 intellectually gifted high school students will be selected.
