PUBLIC SALES ON SCHOOL PROPERTY

No one may sell or offer for sale, within the school, on school grounds, or at school-sponsored activities, any product or service except when the sale will benefit the educational or extracurricular programs of the schools.

Definitions

Extracurricular Programs - Activities conducted by Alexandria City Public Schools (ACPS) that are not part of the ACPS educational program, activities conducted by officials ACPS partners, and/or activities which are conducted with a Permit For Use of School Facilities.

Exceptions

It is permissible for schools to sell certain specialized merchandise pertaining to the individual school, as well as miscellaneous items in school supply stores within school buildings.

School fundraising activities are subject to the approval of the school principal.

Solicitation of Contributions

Solicitations for contributions to charitable organizations, dues for employee organizations, contributions for the benefit of professional organizations, or funds for school or student organizations may only be made outside school hours and using non-school resources. Individual discussions between school division employees regarding such contributions during school hours are not prohibited.

The School Board prohibits non-students from making sales within schools without the approval of the Superintendent or designee, but permits sales by Parent-Teacher Associations or Organizations when authorized by the school principal. It is permissible for schools to sell certain specialized merchandise pertaining to the individual school, as well as miscellaneous items in school supply stores within school buildings.

School fundraising activities shall be are subject to the approval of the school principal.

Solicitation of Contributions

Solicitations for contributions to charitable organizations, dues for employee organizations, contributions for the benefit of professional organizations, or funds for school or student organizations may only be made outside school hours and using non-school resources. Individual discussions between school division employees regarding such contributions during school hours are not prohibited.
