What is Career & Technical Education (CTE) & Workforce Development?

- Career and Technical Education (CTE) provides students with a variety of options to apply academic knowledge and earn the technical skills necessary for the workplace of the 21st century.
- The instructional program along with opportunities for industry credentialing, helps students prepare to be college, career, and civic ready.
- Students may have the opportunity to participate in work-based learning experiences where they can apply classroom knowledge.




