COMMUNITY USE OF SCHOOL FACILITIES

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The Alexandria City School Board (Board) permits the use of school property by members of the community for educational, recreational, civic, and cultural activities, in conformance with applicable law, when such use will not impair the efficiency or educational mission of the school division. Regulation KG-R contains guidelines, the prioritization of use, the application for use of school facilities and a fee schedule for such usage. External requests for the use of any school facilities may be made to the Superintendent or the Superintendent's designee. The Superintendent or Superintendent's designee has the authority to grant such requests on behalf of the Board.

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The Superintendent or designee cooperates with Alexandria City (City) in developing a City Facilities Use and Maintenance Agreement which establishes the guidelines for the mutual use of and maintenance of schools and community facilities by the City and school division. The Superintendent or designee may collaborate with other organizations to develop other similar agreements for the use of school facilities, but all such agreements must be approved by the Board.

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The Superintendent reports actions under this policy to the Board at the end of each month and upon request, focusing on community use of facilities.

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If the Board permits the use of its facilities by members of the community or the distribution of literature on school property or at school functions, it will permit such use or such distribution by the Boy Scouts of America, the Girl Scouts of the United States of America, and other youth groups designated as patriotic societies by federal law, to the same extent and in the same manner as all other persons or groups.

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Designated partners of Alexandria City Public Schools, as defined in Policy KQ, are not charged facility use fees.

COMMUNITY USE OF SCHOOL FACILITIES

The <u>Alexandria City</u> School Board (<u>Board</u>) permits the use of school property by members of the community for educational, recreational, civic, and cultural activities, in conformance with applicable law, when such use will not impair the efficiency or educational mission of the school division. Regulation KG-R contains guidelines, the prioritization of use, the application for use of school facilities and a fee schedule for such usage. External requests for the use of any school facilities_, including the use of T.C. Williams <u>Alexandria City High School Parker-Gray stadium, shall may</u> be made to the Superintendent or the Superintendent's designee. The Superintendent or Superintendent's designee has the authority to grant such requests on behalf of the <u>School</u>Board.

The Superintendent or designee shall-cooperates with the Alexandria City (City) in developing a City Facilities Use and Maintenance Agreement which establishes the guidelines for the mutual use of and maintenance of schools and community facilities by the City and school division. The Superintendent or designee may collaborate with other organizations to develop other similar agreements for the use of school facilities, but all such agreements must be approved by the School Board.

The Superintendent shall-reports actions under this policy to the School Board at the end of each month and upon request, focusing on community use of facilities.

To the extent required by federal and State law and as described in Regulations KF-R and KG-R, <u>DdDesignated</u> youth groups and patriotic organizations recognized by federal law will be permitted to use ACPS facilities and distribute literature on school property to the same extent and in the same manner as all other persons or groups.

If the School Board permits the use of its facilities by members of the community or the distribution of literature on school property or at school functions, it will permit such use or such distribution by the Boy Scouts of America, the Girl Scouts of the United States of America, and other youth groups designated as patriotic societies by federal law, to the same extent and in the same manner as all other persons or groups.

Designated partners of Alexandria City Public Schools, as defined in Policy KQ, are not charged facility use fees.
