Included input from Talented and Gifted Advisory Committee (TAGAC), parents, students, school and division staff via:

- Surveys

- Curriculum and materials review
- Focus group meetings Interviews
- Classroom observations
- Benchmarked against National Association of the Gifted standards

2017-2018

- Reported TAG Evaluation Results, October 12, 2017
  - Four commendations
  - Twenty-eight recommendations
- Formed Steering Committee
- Requested Further Study of service delivery models in surrounding divisions






### **Current Topics Under Discussion**
