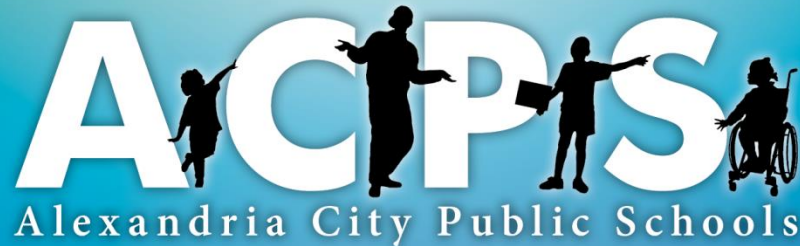

# Essential Questions

# Comparison with Current Policy

- Current policy = 1.5 mile **radius** from each high school campus
- Revised policy = 1.5 mile **walking distance** from each high school campus

# Comparison of TCW Boundaries

Legend:

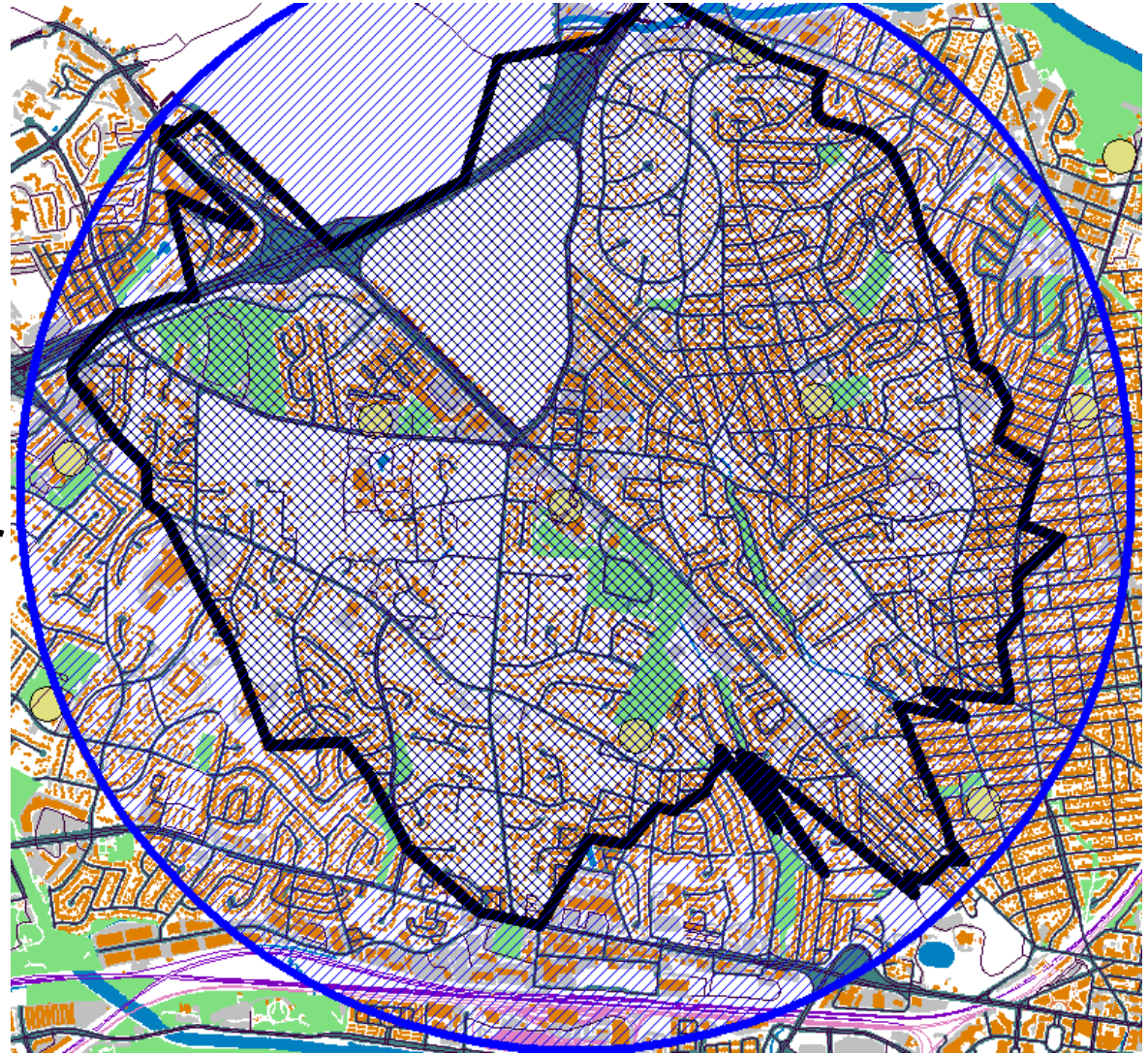
Blue = 1.5 Radius

Black = 1.5 Walk

Changing to  
“walking distance” for  
King St. campus will  
require

+ 406 Riders

+ 4 Buses





# Comparison of MH Boundaries

*Legend:*

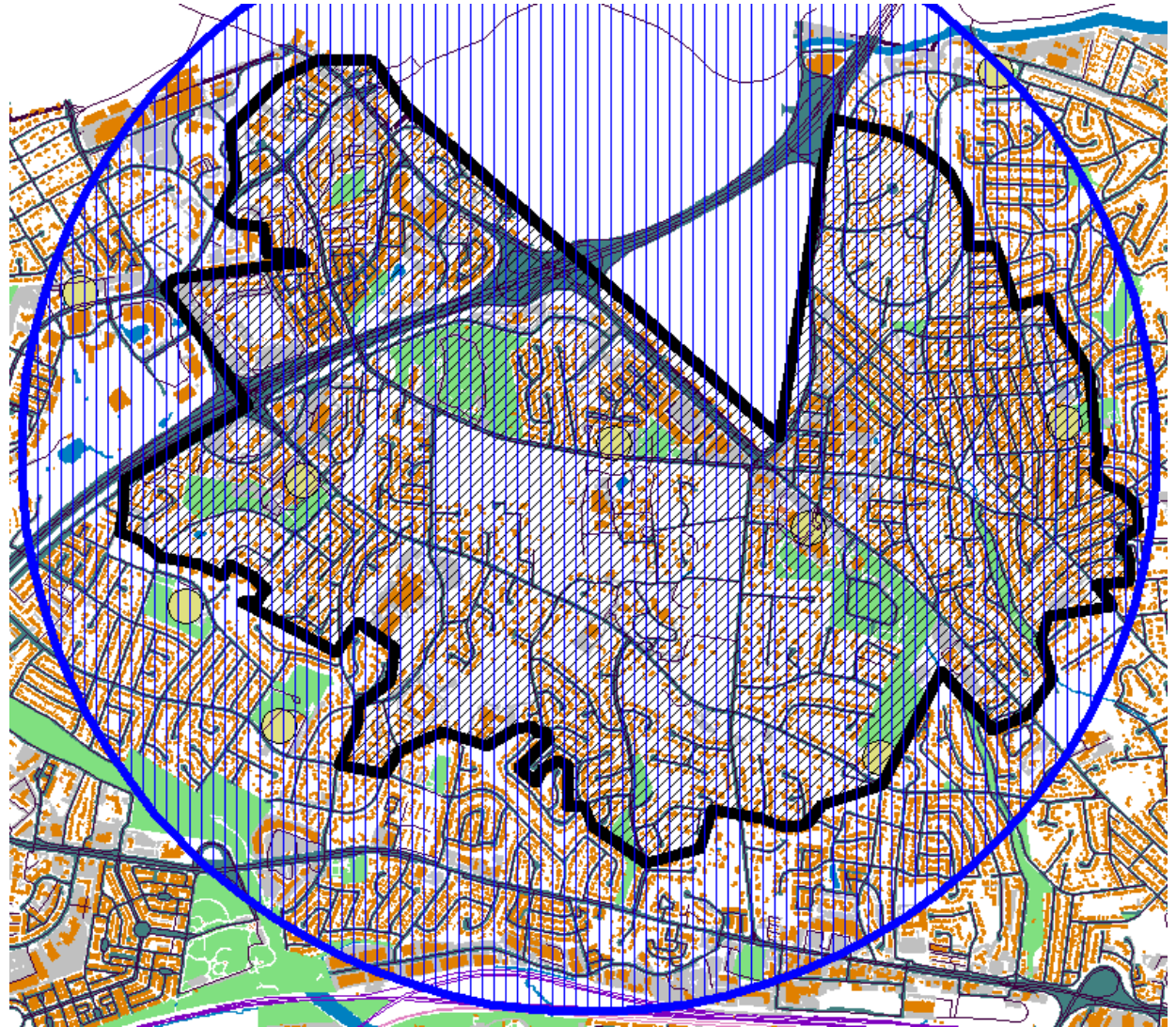
Blue = 1.5 Radius

Black = 1.5 Walk

**Changing to  
“walking distance”  
for Minnie Howard  
campus will require**

+100 Riders

+ 3 Buses



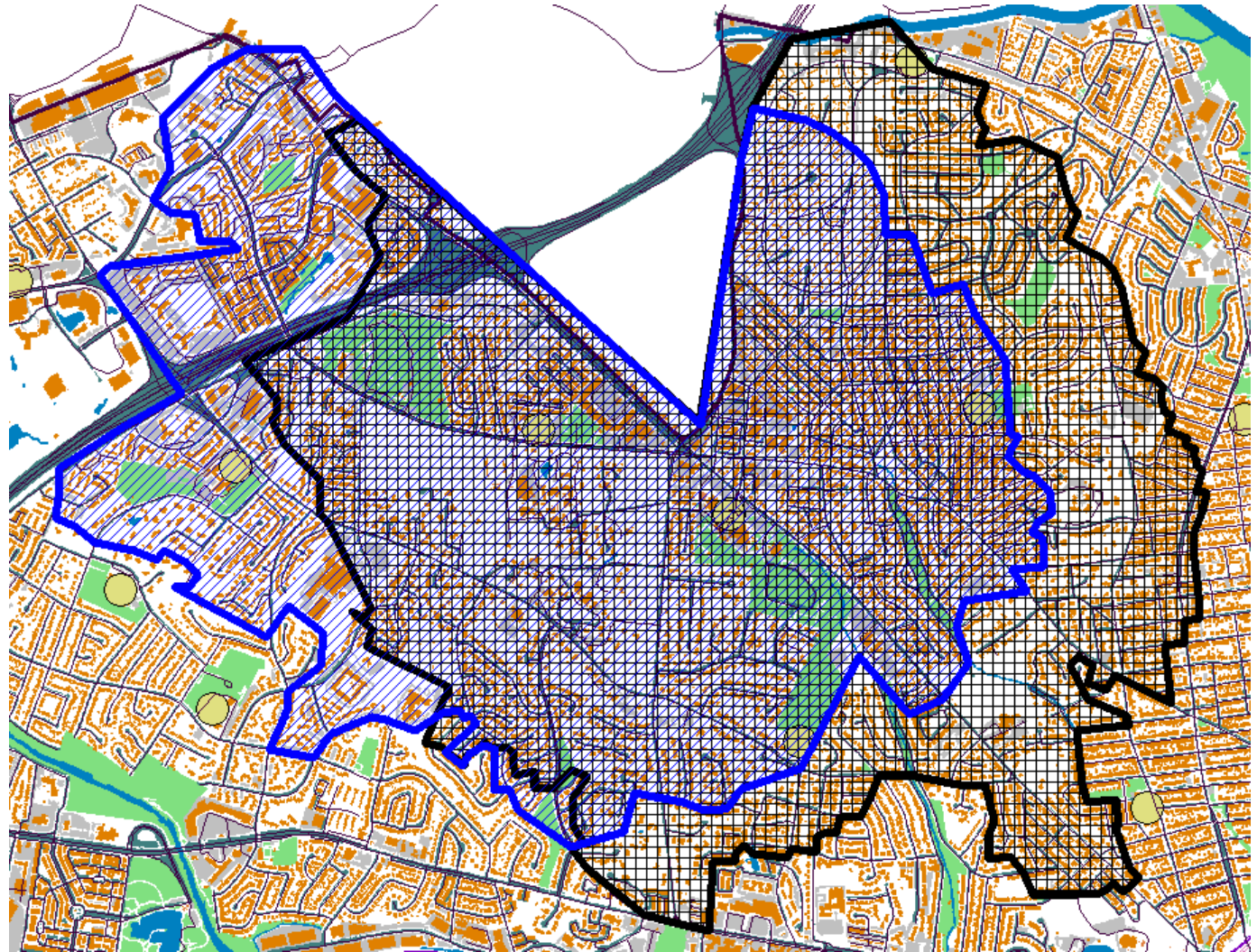


# Proposed King St & MH Boundaries

*Legend:*

Black = King St

Blue = MH



# Impact of Policy Changes

## TC Williams King St and Minnie Howard Campuses

- **King St adds 406 potential AM/PM riders**
  - Avoids Duke Street as a Hazard to cross
  - Avoids Russell Road as a Hazard to cross
  - Adds 4 new bus routes to King Street
  
- **Minnie Howard adds 100 potential AM/PM riders**
  - Currently 62 eight grade students live in the King St walk area
  - Adds 1 new bus route to MH
  - Combines MH with King St on 2 of the new King St routes

  - Recommendation on HS Walk Policy
- ❖ MAY: Bus run paths finalized for Elementary & Middle Schools
- ❖ MAY/JUNE: Notifications to parents (Walk or Ride)
- ❖ Mid-July:
  - Bus stop information to Samuel Tucker for campus dissemination
- ❖ Beginning of August:
  - Bus stop information to PowerSchool for campus dissemination
