- VDOE approved new Standards of Learning for English in 2017
- New materials for grades 6-12 and Advanced Placement and Dual Enrollment Courses:
  - Align with Standards of SOLs, ACPS curriculum, and provide digital access
  - o Include interactive online resources
- Funding was approved as part of the
   FY 2022 Capital Improvement
   Budget


