
Weapons Screening Survey



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


Survey Participation by Role

Question: Do you support the use of weapons screening equipment within ACPS Schools (Overall Response)




- Overall, **85%** of survey respondents **supported** the use of weapons screening equipment in **all or some** schools

 schools

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
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Question: Do you support the use of weapons screening equipment within ACPS schools? (Student and Staff Responses)




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



Level of agreement with the use of weapons screening equipment at each school level



While across settings majority of respondents **supported** use at **each school**, that agreement ratio trended **down** when going from **High School** to **Elementary School** level **Question:** What reasons were most important for you in **supporting** weapons screening equipment in all or some ACPS schools? Reason	%
Overall safer and more secure schools	80%
Weapons entering schools are a significant concern/problem	72%
Less anxiety for students and staff that weapons may enter school	65%
Better screening mechanisms for students, staff and visitors	49%
Other (Please specify)	5%

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Question: What reasons were most important for you **opposing** weapons screening equipment in all or some ACPS schools?(select all that apply)

Reason	%
Placing this equipment in schools negatively impacts "welcoming" feeling	59%
Potential cost to install this equipment in all schools	32%
Other (Please specify)	26%
Additional staff needed to support implementation	25%
Weapons entering schools are not a significant concern/problem	20%
Anxiety for students and staff regarding weapons in school is not a significant concern	19%
Current safety measures for weapons are adequate	19%
